- Cause and effect (This happens, so then that—and that and that happens.)
- Problem and solution (There is this problem. It gets solved in these four ways.)
- Question and answer (There is this question. Here is a long answer. Then, another question and another answer.)
- Compare and contrast (This is the same as that in these ways. It is different in these ways.)
- Description (This looks like...)
